Requirements to Attend Trip

- Student in 10th - 12th grade
- 3.85 weighted GPA
- No discipline reports for first semester

Cost

- The cost to attend the field trip is \$750
- Includes flights and lodging
- Cost of meals is not included. Students will need to bring additional money to purchase their own meals.

Payment Deadlines

- \$50 by November 1, 2018 (required deposit)
- \$250 by December 1, 2018
- \$250 by January 1, 2019
- \$200 by February 1, 2019
